## Science and Technology

This term, students will undertake the unit, "Forces and Energy" whereby they will explore stationary objects that are subjected to pushes and pulls. They investigate how the different strengths of pushes and pulls affect the movement of objects.

The students are introduced to the concept of gravity and consider the effects of objects being pulled towards the Earth. They explore the way objects move on land, through water and in the air.



## English

Reading Groups - each day students will participate in guided reading groups that reinforce decoding, fluency, expression and comprehension skills.

Storybook sessions - students explore a range of quality picture books aimed at developing their vocabulary, comprehension and writing skills.

**Grammar** and Writing - students will focus on expanding their knowledge of sentence structure as well as grammatical features of written texts.

# Geography

#### **Year 1: Features of Places**

Students explore how distance and accessibility influence how often people visit places, and for what purpose. Students investigate connections that people, including Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders People have to local and global places.
