<u>Learning Resources</u> cover the purchase of specific resources used by your child in the classroom. These are an integral part of classroom programs and support your child's learning and development. This includes the purchase of textbooks, scrapbooks, workbooks, IT and other specialty resources. The cost of these resources is determined by the teacher's selection of teaching materials.
